THE GOSPEL OF SAINT JOHN: CHAPTER 4

Jesus sat under Jacob's well. At the same time, a Samaritan woman came to fetch water.

Jesus said with a request: "thank you, give me some water to drink." At that time, his disciples had bought food in the city.

The Samaritan woman answered and said, "You who are Jewish, why do you ask me for water, a Samaritan woman?"

Jesus said, if you knew the gift of God, if you knew who is asking for this water to drink, you would have asked him for it yourself. He would have given you life-giving water."

The woman said to him, "Sir, you don't have a pot to draw with, and this well is deep." Where can you get the life-giving water?

Jesus said, "everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again." But whoever drinks the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will flow from him like a spring of life-giving

water, giving him eternal life." The woman said to him, "Sir, give me that water Lord so that I don't feel thirsty again and have to keep coming here to draw water.

The woman said to him, Sir, I know now that you are a Prophet. Our ancestors worshiped God on this mountain...

Jesus said to him, "Woman, the time is coming and it has already arrived when truly religious people will worship the Father spiritually and truly." God is a spirit and those who worship Him must worship Him spiritually and truly.

The woman left her jar and went to the village and told the people, "Come and see the man who told me everything I did."

Many Samaritans in that village believed in Jesus because of the woman's testimony, that He told me everything I had done.

POINTS TO REFLECT DURING SILENT ADORATION

- We hear in the Gospel that a Samaritan woman met the Lord Jesus at a well.
- Saint Geltrude Comensoli found a well that she left for us as her daughters to draw water and quench our thirst which is the Eucharist.
- People who worship God will no longer worship on the mountain, Jesus said, but they will worship God spiritually and truly.
- Geltrude Comensoli had the same desire to place the Eucharist on a high mountain so that all people could see and worship Him.
- When the Samaritan woman met the Lord Jesus at the well, she returned to the village to announce the Good News to the Villagers and share the joy, love and peace she received from the conversation with the Lord Jesus at the well.
- Mother Geltrude Comensoli was saying that, it would be good and very interesting thing for us Sacramentine sisters to go out of our countries to



announce to others and share them the love and joy we get from our Lord Jesus Christ present in the Eucharist.

- Before her death, our she requested to the Priest and her Sisters: Will the adoration of the Eucharist continue? They all answered YES, IT WILL CONTINUE. This question our mother is still asking to all of us today gathered here to worship our Lord Jesus present in the Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist: will you continue to worship and interact with the Lord Jesus present in the Eucharist?
- ❖ People who worship God will no longer worship on the mountain, Jesus said, but they will worship God in spirit and truth. Geltrude Comensoli had taught us the way to follow.

Recognizing our weakness and failures, in this moment of silence let us enter into our hearts and ask the kindness of Jesus who lives in the Eucharist who is in our midst, to help us recognize our weaknesses so that we can humble ourselves before him and worship him properly.
